## PSHE - Changing Me

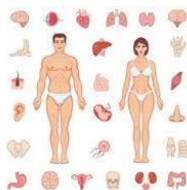
- ★I can explain how girls' and boys' bodies change during puberty and understand the importance of looking after yourself..
