



Dear Year 4 parents,

As a part of our history topic Roman Britain, we have the opportunity to visit Fishbourne Roman Palace on **Wednesday 28th September 2022**. At the palace, the children will have the opportunity to take part in a workshop which covers many aspects of the Roman Era - as well as have a chance to visit the rest of the museum, mosaic and gardens.

The trip will run during the school day - we will leave Meon by coach at around 9:15am and will return for normal pick up at 3:10pm - so children should be dropped off and picked up as usual.

On the day, children will need to wear school uniform, but may wear trainers or comfortable walking shoes, and a raincoat as we will be exploring the museum, some areas of which are outside. Children will need to bring a packed lunch and a water bottle on the day, as well as their inhalers if they require one. Children do not need to bring money as we will not have the opportunity to visit the shop.

The total cost of the trip is £11.25 per child, which covers the cost of the coach and the entry to the museum. The cost is payable via Parentmail, under 'payment'/ and then 'shop' option. We ask that payment is made by 23rd September please. If sufficient money is not collected, we will be unable to run the trip. If you are available to help out on the day, please make yourself known to your child's class teacher - your support would be greatly appreciated.
